We have and will continue to provide value to our members with safety and security protecting your deposits. This crisis will pass, and we will emerge stronger together.

With tax season in full swing, you want to take action so as to not fall victim to an IRS tax scam. Some important things to remember:

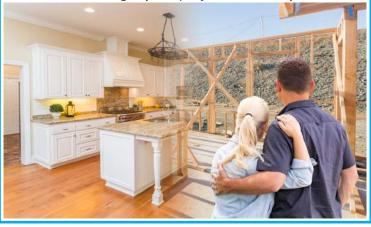
- 1. The IRS will never call about an unanticipated tax refund
- 2. The IRS will not begin with threats of law enforcement
- 3. The IRS will never demand payment via gift cards, prepaid cards, or wire transfer.

If you receive on of these calls you should hang up immediately, do not give out any personal information if you suspect fraud. Report this type of call directly to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration via their online complaint form.

To gain access to the new platform on your smart device simply download our new app; named "Members" Choice PA FCU". Once the app is downloaded you will be able to use your old login information to enter the new platform. Members can also reach the new online program from the "Sign In" button on our website or going directly to my.mcfcu.org. From a security standpoint, we do recommend changing your password: not just for the conversion, but every few months or so to ensure you lessen the risk of fraud. All of your information: billpay payees, transfers, etc. will carry over. No need to start from scratch! The only thing mobile users will need to do is re-enroll for Mobile Deposit. Once your application is approved, you will once again be able to remotely deposit checks up to your limit. Although Mobile Deposit posting times will slightly be changing with the new platform, this alternative solution is so that we could provide a better digital banking experience overall. Along with these changes, we will no longer be offering text banking as the new platform will provide all necessary banking functions to perform from anywhere you have access to internet.
