Summer time usually means vacation time! Follow these three travel tips to stay safe while you relax this summer.

- 1. While cards are safer to travel with, don't put all of your eggs in one basket. Bring a backup form of payment, like an additional debit/credit card, just in case yours is lost, stolen, or compromised.
- 2. Inform your financial institutions and credit card companies of your travel plans. If uncharacteristic purchases suddenly pop up on your card, they may be declined to protect you from fraud. Letting your financial institutions know where you plan on making purchases will save you from potential declined charges.
- 3. Provide updated contact information. If your financial institutions want to confirm whether or not a purchase is fraudulent and they cannot reach you, your card may be blocked until they can get a hold of you.
