Welcome to MC Federal Credit Union; how can we help you? To many of you this may sound familiar as we have returned to operations under a Federal Charter. The vote overwhelmingly supported the Board's Resolution to convert the charter. Thank you for your support on this important decision.

As this newsletter goes to press, we have received conversion approval and are waiting for our charter number assignment by receipt of the official charter document.

I thought it would be prudent to address a few of the questions you may have on how this change will impact you. The simple answer is business as usual. You should continue to use your Members Choice checks. The routing and account numbers will remain the same. When it is time to reorder, the new checks

will have the MC Federal name on them.

Your Debit and Credit Cards are not impacted. When your cards are due to be reissued the new cards will have the MC Federal name on them.

Over the next several weeks you will see the transition of signs, posters, billboards, and other credit union documents to the MC Federal Credit Union name.

There is one thing that will not change. The purpose and passion that we serve our members with will remain steadfast. This change positions us to expand our footprint geographically and add additional (SEG) groups more efficiently, a true enabler to our people helping people mantra. Being there in your time of need is our focus and this change has removed the barriers that hinder us from doing so. We will be sharing some exciting news on this topic over the next several weeks.

As we cautiously maneuver through the pandemic, we will be modifying some of the steps we put in place to protect our members and employees. Effective July 1, 2021 we will drop our mask requirement for members who have had their COVID vaccinations. We do request that members who have not been vaccinated continue to wear a mask. This virus has many mutations and we must be vigilant in our quest to be safe. We will still maintain our plastic barriers as a layer of protection as well as continuing our enhanced cleaning procedures.



## 5 Financial Tips for Summer Travel

Before you hit the road this summer it's important keep these 5 financial tips in mind.

- 1. Notify your financial institution about your travel plans in advance. This will help them monitor your accounts for suspicious activity and help ensure that you can use your card for purchases while you are traveling.
- 2. Mind Your Money. It's easy to get carried away and overspend while you are traveling. Keep track of your account balance with mobile banking and balance alerts to keep your spending on track. You can also opt to use a prepaid card with a set balance if you need help sticking to your budget.
- 3. Be Aware of What You Share. Think twice before you post your upcoming vacation plans on social media. Letting strangers know that your house will be empty for a few days can put you at risk for an attempted burglury.
  - Also, before using a public network at a hotel or café, for example ask an employee for the specific network name and whether it requires a security key for access. To play it safe, do not access your personal or financial information using any unsecured network.
- 4. Act Fast if you Lose a Card. If your debit/credit card is misplaced or possibly stolen, act quickly to help prevent fraudulent transactions. With Digital Banking, our members can use the card management tile to turn a debit card off. Once the card is recovered, you can simply turn it back on.
- 5. Monitor for Fraud. Even if you think you have been extra careful, its important to monitor for fraud. Set up account alerts before traveling, and use your banking app on a secured Wi-Fi network to monitor your account and card activity while traveling. Alert your financial institution or card issuer to unusual or unauthorized activity as soon as possible. Continue to monitor your account when you return home to ensure you are not a victim of delayed travel fraud.
